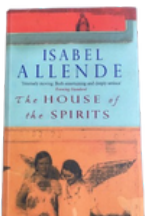
### Este mes celebramos ....

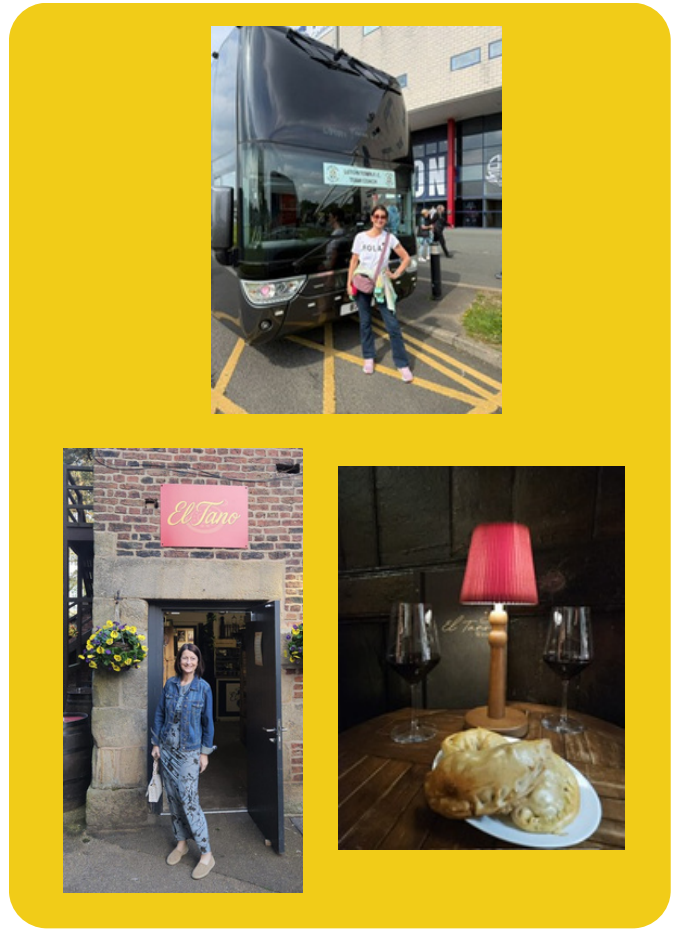
